


Spring 2025 Enrollment Report

Longitudinal Enrollment Growth

Valencia College's Spring 2025 enrollment represents the largest Spring semester <u>ever</u> at the college – surpassing last Spring's historical record. Full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollment grew nearly 7% from Spring 2024 to Spring 2025, increasing to 14,345. The previous high was 13,423 FTE in Spring 2024. Valencia is also experiencing its highest unduplicated Spring headcount on record at 47,757 students, which represents a nearly 6.5% increase from Spring 2024.



Enrollment by Student Type

This record-setting enrollment reflects an increase in new students as well as returning students. Returning students account for 73% of overall enrollment in any given term.

Enrollment by Student Modality

For Spring 2025, 50.2% of students are enrolled in at least one face-to-face class. This is consistent with the prior spring term.

Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

Hispanic students make up just over 49% of the overall Spring 2025 enrollment. The demographics of students enrolled at Valencia College broadly reflect the demographics of our service district.
