The Valencia College Foundation Vision-Based Strategic Plan Update

The Valencia College Foundation is currently in Year 2 of its Vision-Based Strategic Plan—a three-year roadmap designed to guide the Foundation in advancing growth and long-term sustainability. This plan is intentionally aligned with Valencia College's Strategic Impact Plan, which is designed to improve the educational and economic outlook for the Central Florida community.

In close partnership with the Board of Directors, the Foundation is actively making meaningful progress across the plan's three strategic pillars: Advancement, Operations, and Governance. These efforts are helping to strengthen the Foundation's capacity to support students, faculty, and the broader college community now and into the future.

Philanthropic Highlights:

- \$40,000 from Bank of America to provide gap funding support to students who
 are seeking a high-wage career in a high-demand industry by upskilling or
 reskilling in one of Valencia College's accelerated skills training programs. Since
 2020, Bank of America has provided \$465,000 in support of accelerated skills
 training students.
- \$26,000 from the Winter Park Lifelong Learning Foundation (WPLLF) to create an endowed scholarship to support Valencia College students who are residents of Winter Park, have a 3.0 GPA or higher and have completed at least 30 credit hours toward an A.A. or A.S. degree. WPLLF was founded in 2024 to foster lifelong learning for all generations by bringing relevant education to modern adults and empowering younger generations to pursue higher learning. One hundred percent of tuition funds for all courses are donated to the Valencia College Foundation to support the Winter Park Lifelong Learning Foundation Scholarship.
