
RE: INSTITUTIONAL GENERAL EDUCATION COURSE OFFERINGS

In accordance with State Board of Education Rule 6A-14.0303, each Florida College System institution district board of trustees and president must annually review and approve, at a public meeting, the courses offered by the institution that meet general education course requirements.

Due to the comprehensive review conducted by the College in 2024 that was guided by the principles recommended by the Board, no changes to the College's general education course offerings are recommended for the 2025-26 academic year.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The President recommends that the District Board of Trustees approve the institutional general education courses as recommended and presented, for submission to the State Articulation Coordinating Committee, leading to final consideration and approval of the State Board of Education.
