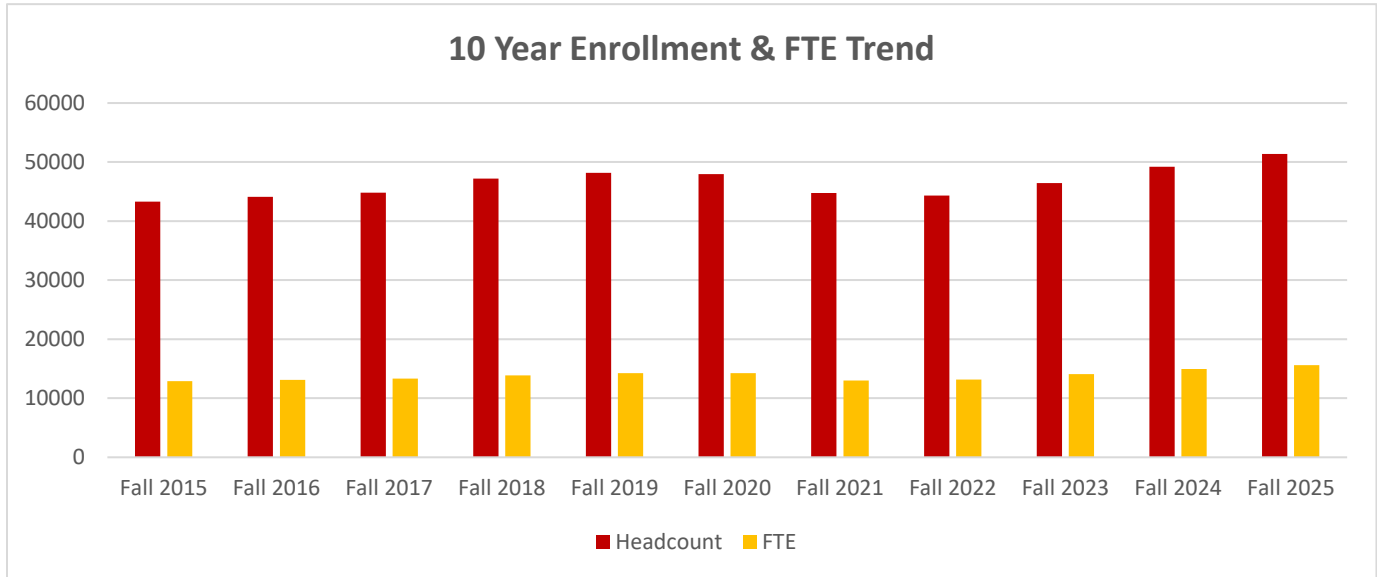


Fall 2025 Enrollment Report

Headcount & Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment

At 20 days after semester start, unduplicated headcount for Fall 2025 is 51,353, representing our highest ever Fall enrollment. In fact, this marks the first time that Fall headcount enrollment exceeded 50,000. The total number of students enrolled at Valencia increased 3.6% from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025, and full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment (a measure of credit hours) increased 3.9%.



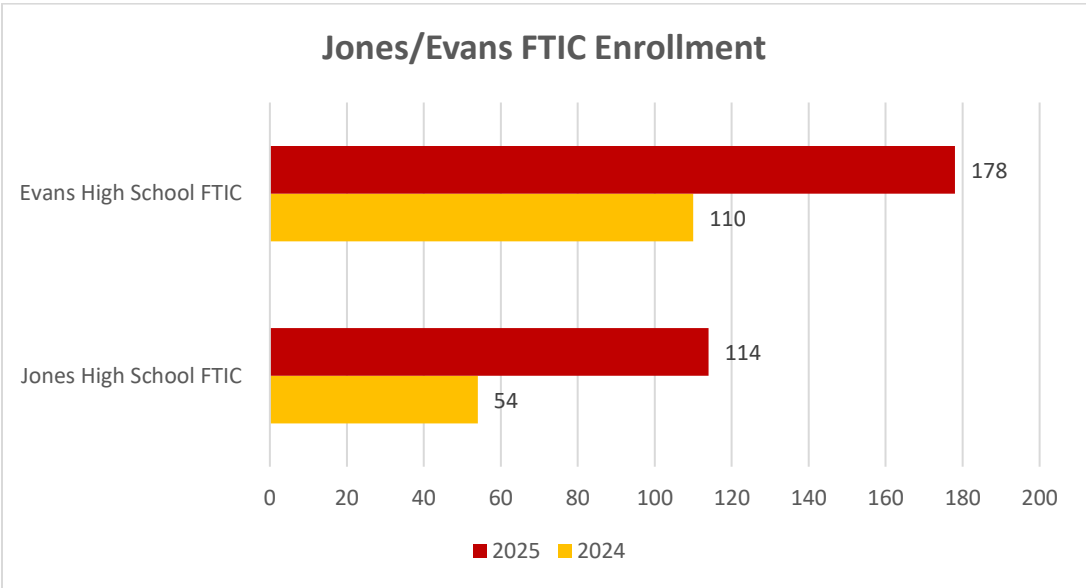
Enrollment by Student Type

Fall enrollment continues the pattern of growth seen in recent semesters. Returner student enrollment increased 6.3%, which accounts for just over 60% of our overall enrollment. First-Time-in-College (FTIC) enrollment increased only slightly at 0.9%. Dual Enrollment increased 6% with the bulk of that increase from “returner” dual enrolled students.

Jones/Evans FTIC Enrollment

Fall 2025 is the first semester of the Jones/Evans College Access Program. There is a 62% increase in FTIC students from Evans High School for Fall 2025 and there is a 111% increase in FTIC students from Jones High School.



Enrollment by Modality

The following charts provide an overview of enrollments by modality disaggregated by degree type. For our Associate in Arts students, which is our largest cohort of students (60% of our overall headcount enrollment), 20% are enrolled in onsite only, 40% are enrolled in online only, and the remaining 40% are enrolled in a combination of onsite and online courses. For our Associate in Science students, which is our second largest cohort of students, 25% are enrolled in onsite only, 45% are enrolled in online only, and the remaining 30% are enrolled in a combination of online and onsite courses.
