Medical Examinations

Policy Statement:

- A. After five (5) days of absence due to illness, in a thirty (30) calendar-day period, the president or a designee may require that an employee furnish a medical certificate by a qualified health care provider on a form prescribed by the College. This is to be done at the expense of the employee.
- B. In addition, the president or a designee may require that an employee at any time submit to a medical exam by a qualified physician to be selected by the employee from a list consisting of not less than three names provided by the District Board of Trustees and allow a copy of the exam to be submitted to the District Board of Trustees. One copy will be forwarded to the employee. This is to be done at the expense of the District Board of Trustees.
