The Fringe benefits variance is due to journal entries made for the distribution of the FY2122 Health Insurance Subsidy & FRS Pension contributions. As a result of an increase in investment returns, the funded ratio was higher, causing the college's proportionate share of net pension expense to decrease. The Total materials/services expense last year included a one time payment to FLVC of \$706,913 so the number this year is back to a more normal range for these expenses. Both of these caused the Total Expenses to be less than the year before.
