Reports for Fall 2019 and forward has been recreated to account for updates to Dual Enrollment and Deanery changes. Full Term, H2, and TWK were not administered due to COVID changes.

This report was pulled from the Data Warehouse using data in Banner. "Department" was used to organize the report. Department is defined using the department code referenced in the Catalog, Recruiting, Admissions, and other modules in Banner. This report reflects the information taken at the time of report creation and reflects the information currently held in Banner. It does not reflect any recent changes to academic programs (degree areas).

Deanerys are defined using guidelines provided by Institutional Research and are current as on the time this report was created. The expected response rates shown reflect the number of invitations sent. They were sent to any student enrolled as of the day prior to the launch date shown on the administration calendar (http://tiny.cc/SFI\_calendar). This calendar has been determined in accord with faculty decisions about the opening and closing dates of the survey.
