When applying to Valencia College, a student's primary or secondary major is declared as "Pending Nursing."

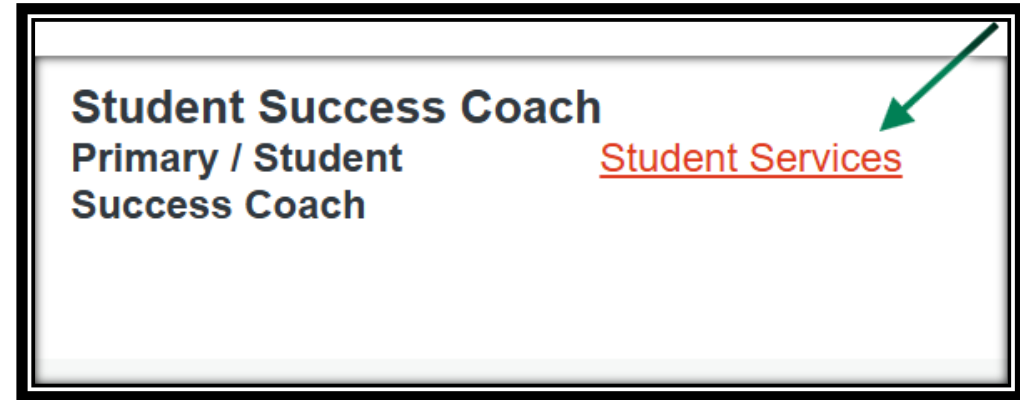

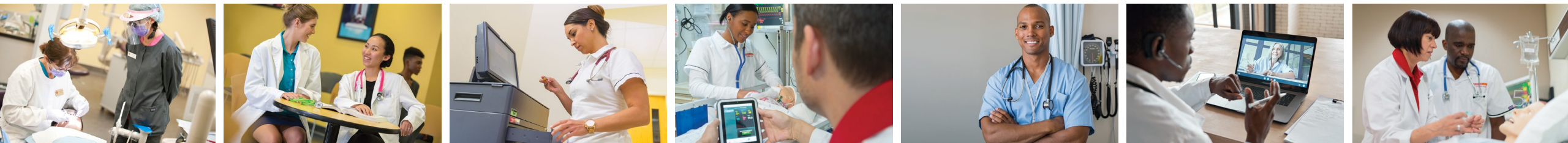

Offered at state colleges and universities, this program allows current nurses to further their education and enhance career advancement opportunities.



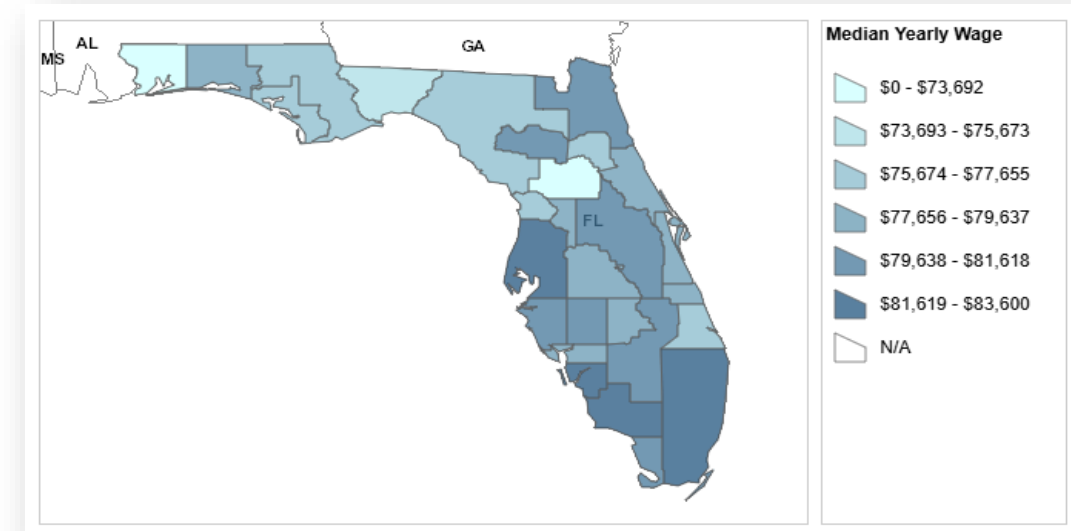

# RN to BSN, Admission Requirements

- ✓ Completion of Associate Degree in Nursing from regionally or nationally accredited institution
- ✓ Minimum 2.0 overall GPA
- ✓ Clear/active, unrestricted, unencumbered Florida RN license -or- are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) and earn RN license within the first term
- ✓ U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or non-immigrant category other than F or J visa categories (\*international students are ineligible)

**Note:** Admission is non-competitive

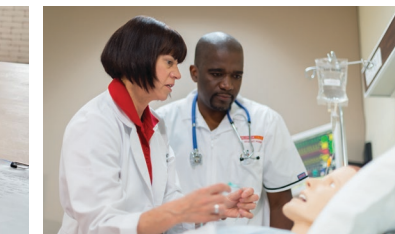
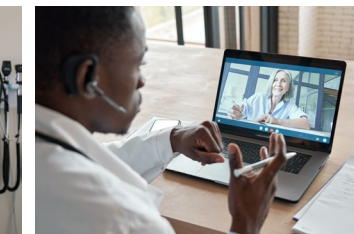
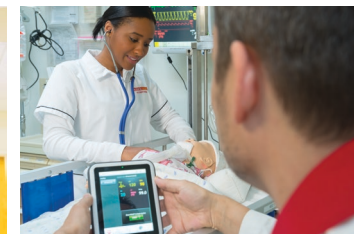
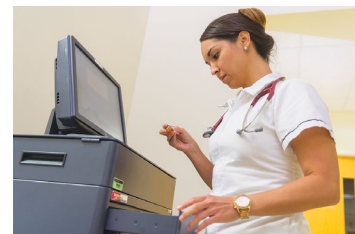
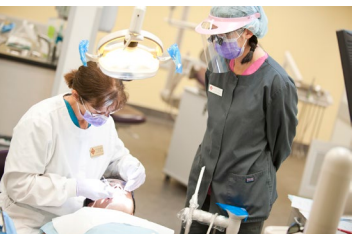






## Life in the A.S. Nursing Program: Clinical Experiences
