

Types of Nursing Education & Degrees

Associate in Arts (A.A.)

Two-year degree from state and community colleges, designed for students aiming to transfer to a University Traditional BSN program.

Associate of Science in Nursing (A.S.N.)

Two-year degree from state and community colleges, designed for immediate workforce entry and potential BSN completion.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing, RN to BSN

Offered at state colleges and universities, this program allows current nurses to further their education and enhance career advancement opportunities.



Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN)

The RN to BSN Program provides an opportunity for individuals who hold an A.S. degree in Nursing from an accredited institution to further their education and increase their potential for career advancement.

Program Location:

Online, asynchronous courses, <u>except</u> for the experiential learning component during NUR 3634C Community & Public Health Nursing and NUR 4945C Nursing Capstone courses

Length of Program:

- Self-paced
 varies based on credits upon entering program
- Range: One year completion (If *general education* courses completed) or (1) course per term

RN to BSN, Admission Requirements

- ✓ Completion of Associate Degree in Nursing from regionally or nationally accredited institution
- ✓ Minimum 2.0 overall GPA
- ✓ Clear/active, unrestricted, unencumbered Florida RN license -or- are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) and earn RN license within the first term
- ✓ U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or non-immigrant category other than F or J visa categories (*international students are ineligible)

Locations: West Campus or Osceola Campus (preference not guaranteed)


Admission Requirements: Must meet criteria for both Valencia and UCF


