

- subject area content requirements for ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (GRADES K 6) as documented by
 - 1. a passing score on the ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (GRADES K 6) subject area examination earned
- 2. 30 semester hours in elementary education to include the areas specified below:
 - a course in teaching reading in grades K-6 which includes understanding the reading process and
 - a course in teaching reading in grades K-6 which includes recognition and assessment of reading
 - a course in teaching reading in grades K-6 which includes prescription and utilization of appropriate methods and materials to increase reading performance
 - a course in content and methods for teaching writing and language arts in grades K-6
 - a course in content and methods for teaching science for grades K-6
 - a course in content and methods for teaching social science for grades K-6
- a course in content and methods for teaching health education and physical education for grades K-6
- a course in content and methods for teaching art for grades K-6
- a course in content and methods for teaching music for grades K-6
- a course in content and methods for teaching mathematics for grades K-6
- a course in materials for use in grades K-6 such as children's literature, multi-media materials, library materials, and the computer as an instructional tool
- maintain a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) in the subject area

- verification of employment and request for issuance of certificate on the appropriate certification form from a
 Horida public, state supported, or nonpublic school which has an approved Professional Education
 Competence Program
- results of your fingerprint processing from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the FBI. Your
 employer will assist you in completing the fingerprint process. If your application or fingerprint report
 reflects a criminal offense or suspension revocation record, your file will be referred to Professional Practices
 Services for further review. Issuance of your certificate will be contingent upon the results of this review.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE: For issuance of a Professional Educator's Certificate valid for five years covering BIOLOGY (GRADES 6 - 12), the above requirements for a Temporary Certificate must be completed, and a CG-10 Application Form, appropriate non-refundable application fee, and official documentation of the following requirements must be submitted to the Bureau of Educator Certification:

- A passing score on the Florida General Knowledge Test. Current Florida law requires that an individual satisfy this requirement within one year from the date of employment in a Florida public school to continue employment under the Temporary Certificate in any Florida public school. Contact your employer for important information concerning this decadline.
- · a passing score on the Professional Education Test
- a passing score on the BIOLOGY (GRADES 6 12) subject area examination
- completion of a Florida approved Professional Education Competence Program administered and documented by your employer

- a minimum of 9 additional semester hours in education courses with credit in each of the following professional education areas:
 - · classroom management including safe learning environments
 - human development and learning
 - educational assessment to include the content measured by state achievement tests and the interpretation and utilization of data to improve student achievement
 - effective instructional strategies including the needs of diverse learners
- · curriculum and special methods of teaching SCIENCE in the middle or secondary school
- foundations of research-based practices in teaching reading
- the Practical Teaching Experience requirement by completing one year of full-time teaching experience in an elementary or secondary school

Please note that all of the above courses, except human development and learning, must be taken at the junior, senior, or graduate level.
