
## 2024-2025 Career Pathways Consortium Articulation Agreement Between

# Valencia Graphic and Interactive Design Program and Orange/Osceola School Districts Digital Design Program

High school students can earn Valencia College credits in the articulated Associate in Science degree program by meeting the following requirements: 1. Complete each required secondary Digital Design course with "C" or better. 2. Prior to high school graduation, students must pass Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign certifications or end of course exam and graphics portfolio, and earn one Expert level certification in Photoshop, Illustrator or InDesign. 3. Enroll and attend Valencia College after high school graduation. Valencia College will award Career Pathways credits up to 24 months after high school graduation. Students wishing to transfer these Career Pathways credits to another college or university should first check with that institution. Please note: The following courses can only be applied to Graphic and Interactive Design A.S. degree program at Valencia College.

1. Complete required secondary course.

2. Pass required industry certifications and joint assessment.

Assessments for award of credit are passing one assessment from 1) or 2) and completion of Graphics Portfolio in 3) as specified below:

- 1) Passing score on **all** of the following three (3) Adobe certifications: Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign *or*
- 2) Minimum score of 70% on end of course exam approved by Valencia faculty and graded by high school faculty.

AND

3) All portions of portfolio must be included and must meet the rubric requirements. High school faculty guide and direct assignments, and upon completion, assignments are submitted to Valencia faculty for grading as either electronic multi-page PDFs or as hard copies in binders. Please include rubric provided with each portfolio.

1. Complete required secondary courses.

2. Pass required industry certifications.

Assessment for award of credit is earning a minimum of *one* Expert Level certification in any of these certifications: Photoshop, Illustrator or InDesign. *Please note:* Credit is awarded based on the industry certification in which the Expert Level certification is earned as follows: Photoshop = GRA 2201C; Illustrator = GRA 2156C; and InDesign = GRA 1203C.
