• Paper format

- New title page for students (2.2)
- o Running head not required for student papers; student paper only includes page number
- o Five heading levels changed: all bold and title case, but varies in position/italicization (2.3)
- New formatting guidance for annotated bibliographies (9.51)

• Writing style, grammar, mechanics

- Singular 'they' is endorsed (4.18)
- One space after period (6.1)
- o Broader use of quotations marks (instead of italics) (6.7)

In-text citations (examples listed in inside front cover of manual)

- Simplified in-text citations
 - Works with 3 or more authors, shortened to name of first author and et al. (8.17) unless there is ambiguity with same authors (8.18)

Reference list (examples listed in inside back cover of manual)

- How to handle missing information (9.1)
- o Up to 20 authors now included before names omitted with ellipses (9.8)
- Include the issue number for all periodicals that have issue numbers (9.25)
- Updated guidelines about when to include DOIs and URLs from sources in databases
 - Both DOI and URL are presented as hyperlinks, the DOI label is no longer used and words "retrieved from" are only used when retrieval date is also needed (when a work may change over time and not have archived versions) (9.35)
 - For works from most databases with no DOI, don't include a URL; reference should be the same as for a print source (9.34)
 - For works from databases that publish works of limited circulation (like some documents from ERIC) or original, proprietary material, include the name of the database/archive and the URL of the work (9.34)
- Book references now omit publisher location (10.2)
- Expanded coverage of audiovisual materials, social media, and websites (10.12-10.16)
 - New references category created for webpages and websites, requiring the title of the page/site to be in italics (10.16)
