

### Example: Periodical Article - No Pagination




In-text citation: Woodard explains that "text of quotation."

OR

"Text of quotation" (Woodard)

### Example: Journal Article - Two Authors




In-text citation: According to Alamar and Glance "text of quotation" (525).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Alamar and Glance 525).

**Example: Book Entry - No Author**



In-text citation: "Renewable" explains that "text of quotation" (521).

OR

"Text of quotation" ("Renewable").
