## **Important Information!**

- 1. You MUST apply by the program application deadline on the SAGE website in order to qualify for the trip and SAGE scholarship.
- 2. Application fee and deposit payments are made to the Business Office with supporting documentation from the SAGE Office.
- 3. The application fee is ONLY refundable if the program is cancelled due to low enrollment.
- 4. Once the deposit payment is paid, there is NO refund for any fees past or future.
- 5. You will not see the application fee or the deposit amount paid in your Atlas account because the money is not charged as program tuition.
- 6. If you have financial aid, the system will automatically apply those funds to any balance pending. You must check in Atlas to see if there is a final amount due to pay. Final balance payments are made directly to your Atlas account and NOT the Business Office.
- 7. It is imperative that you pay by the deadlines published on the SAGE website or you will be dropped from the course and will still owe the total amount due to Valencia College! It is your responsibility to pay any remaining balance after all financial aid, scholarships, and third-party funding have been applied to your account, and to ensure your account has a zero balance PRIOR TO DEPARTURE or the payment deadline specified on the Important Dates and Deadlines calendar (whichever comes first).
- 8. The system does not discriminate between fees for study abroad and fees for other charges, so if you have a balance in your Atlas account and do not pay by Valencia College's payment deadline, you will be dropped from the course and scholarships will no longer appear on your account.
- 9. If you decide to drop the course after the deposit payment deadline, you will STILL BE RESPONSIBLE for the total study abroad program fee since these fees have already been paid to the program provider.
- 10. All fees, credits, and scholarship amounts are subject to change.
- 11. \*\*Out-of-state tuition applies to students who are not Florida residents. If you are paying out-of-state tuition for your other courses, you will also pay out-of-state tuition for a study abroad course.
- 12. If the total of your scholarships and grants exceeds the balance due, you may be eligible for a return credit of this amount. Outstanding balances due to the college could affect disbursement of this credit.
