
About six-in-ten Americans (61%) say the higher education system in the United States is going in the wrong direction, according to a new Pew Research Center survey.

*% saying each is a major reason why the higher education system is going in the wrong direction, among those who think it is going in the wrong direction*



*% saying each is a major reason why the higher education system is going in the wrong direction, among those who think it is going in the wrong direction*





# BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS

That's \$6,470 per year.

According to the state, a Valencia AS degree gives an average \$22,000 per year pay increase over an Orange/Osceola County HS diploma.


