








Intensive English Program - Osceola Campus Enrollments FY1415 - FY1819/YTD Unduplicated vs. Duplicated Students







Intensive English Program – Osceola Campus Top Ten Places of Origin FY1718









Impact of New CAT – Osceola Campus




Intensive English Program - Osceola Campus **Enrollment Year-over-Year Comparison** Jan-Feb 2018 to Jan-Feb 2019








ESOL Program Enrollment History FY1314 - FY1819/YTD

YouthBuild Program



YouthBuild at Osceola Campus

- First started in 2017
- Partnership between CareerSource Central Florida, Goodwill, and Osceola Council on Aging
- Provides GED and Construction training to at-risk youth
- Currently have 84% graduation rate
