

The broad goal of this project is to scale a cross-institutional and multi-dimensional course-based andergraduate research experience to improve andergraduate STEM education. There are seven astitutions involved in this project. Anitza San Miguel will serve as lead on this project for Valencia, and will en amed a Co-PI. UF will provide a sub-award of 30,000 over three years. In year 1 of the grant, UF and fillsborough Community College will develop modules for faculty to use in their General Biology, Microbiology, and/or Introduction to Biotechnology ourses.
