

## Florida State Board of Education 2020-21 Proposed Education Budget Request

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## Policy Alignment: College & Career Readiness

- \$24 million increase to College funding tiered approach to better align with student growth and demand
- \$16 million increase for Dual Enrollment Scholarships for home, summer and private school students
- \$10 million increase to Performance Funding creating a new Dual Enrollment component
- \$5 million increase for Postsecondary Certificates
- \$11 million increase for District-Level Certificates
- \$1.5 million for Last Mile College Completion new
- \$1 million increase for Underserved Students' Access to Advanced Placement (AP) courses
- \$1 million increase for College Industry Certification Incentives

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## Policy Alignment: Fixed Capital Outlay

- Fixed Capital Outlay Total Recommendation \$1.6 billion:
- \$263.6 million for Maintenance Repair, Renovation and Remodeling
  - \$173.9 million for Charter Schools (equity with traditional public schools)
  - \$37.8 million for the Florida College System (per statutory formula)
- \$50.0 million for the Educational Facilities Security Grant
- \$41.3 million for Special Facility Construction
  - \$7.2 million for Gilchrist (3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 years)
  - \$8.5 million for Baker (1st of 3 years)
  - \$13.2 million for Bradford (1st of 3 years)
  - \$12.4 million for Levy (1st of 3 years)
- \$28 million for Florida College System Projects

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
