What Is Early Alert?

- All Poinciana Campus professors submit grades for students in jeopardy of failing (D, F, W) by mid-semester.
- Compile the results to figure out students failing 1 class, 2 classes, and 3+ classes.





Early Alert Student Outreach

Conduct targeted and personalized outreach to students via phone,

email, and texting campaigns:

- Academic advising
- Academic support plan
- Financial aid advising
- Learning support tutoring by discipline
- Professor support via Faculty Development
- Learning support and professor partnerships embedded tutoring



Early Alert Outcomes

- Ensures students know where they stand academically by midterm.
- Promotes conversations between faculty and students at midterm.
- Improves course success and retention rates.
- Allows us to identify data trends to better advise students on the front end.
- Allows us to identify data trends to create learning support interventions in real time.
