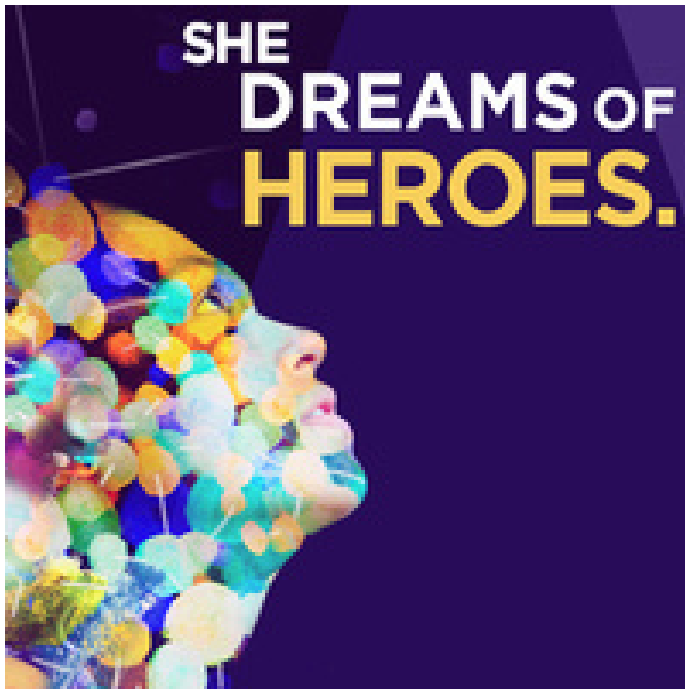

Choreographers' Showcase

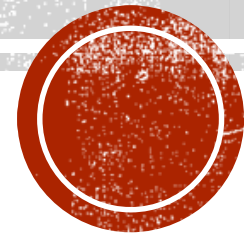

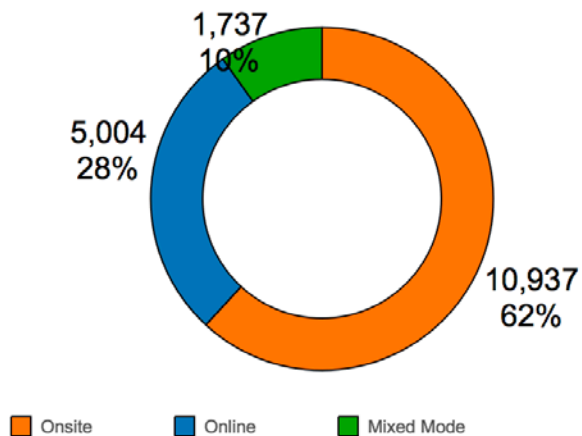

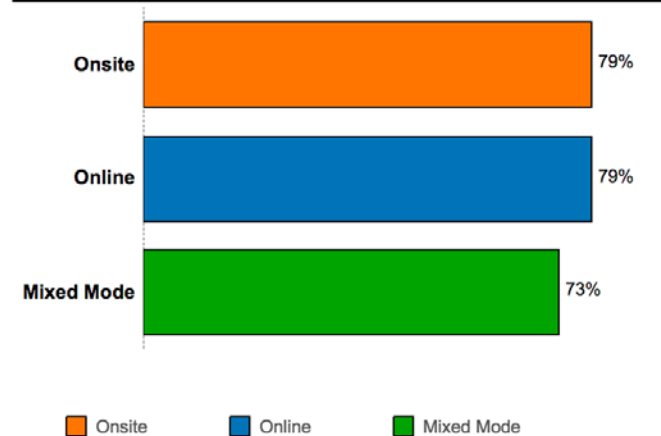

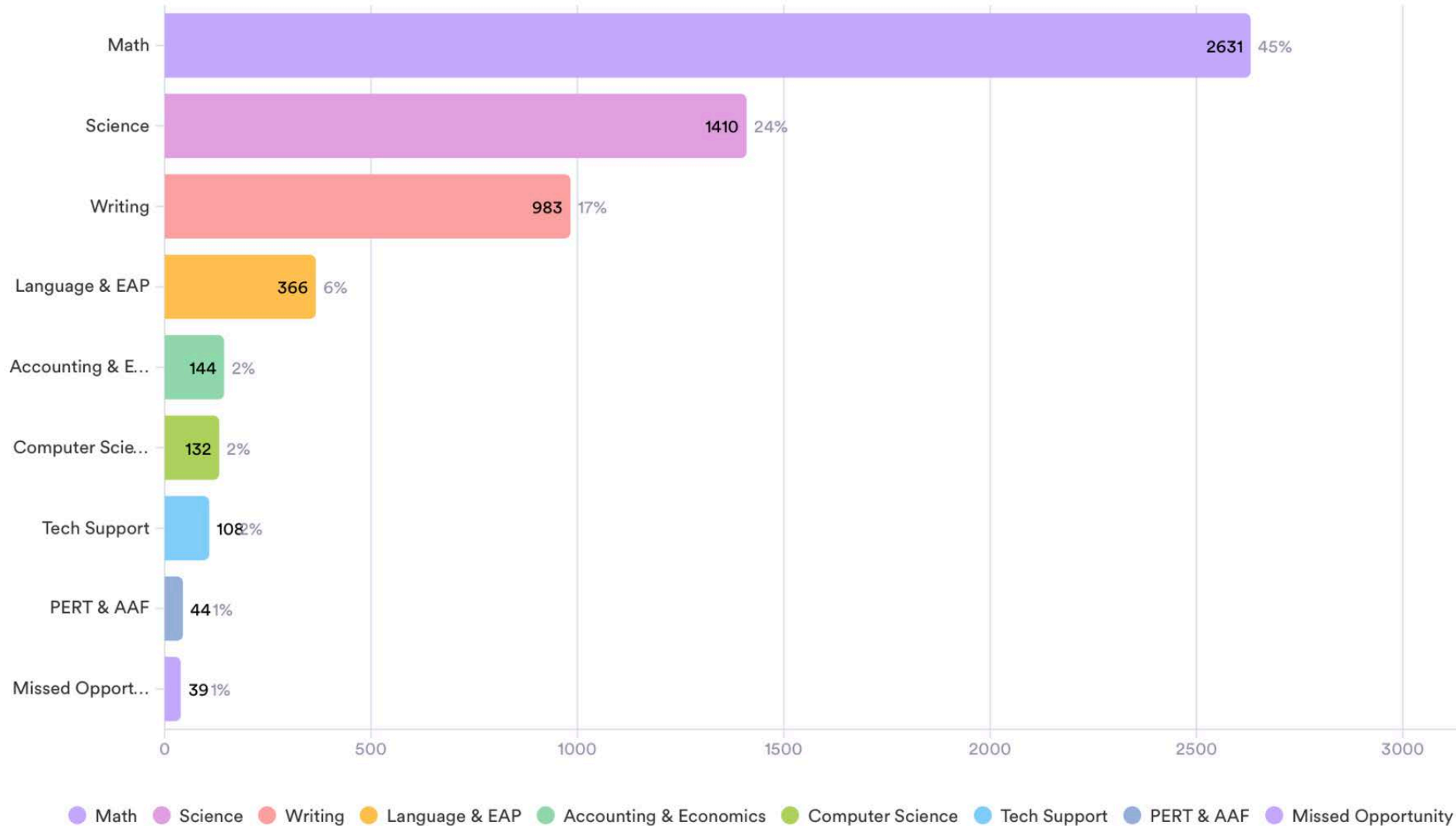
