Minutes

November 18, 2020 Valencia College – West Campus, Room 8-111 and Teleconference/Zoom Meeting

Call to Order	Chair Stockwell called the Special Meeting of the District Board of Trustees of Valencia College to order at 9:34am. A quorum was present.

New Business – Presidential Search Process	 Determination and Approval of Presidential Candidates for the Position of President, Valencia College: Chair Stockwell reported that the Presidential Search Committee reached a consensus on an unranked slate of presidential finalist candidates to be recommended to the District Board of Trustees of Valencia College for review and consideration.
	Chair Stockwell thanked the members of the Presidential Search Committee for their active engagement, valuable insight and perspective while reviewing and discussing the application materials submitted by presidential candidates under consideration for the position of President, Valencia College.

Chair Stockwell thanked Valencia's faculty, staff, and students for their robust participation and feedback in one or more of the College's Presidential Search town hall events.

Chair Stockwell recognized the College's staff for their great efforts and engagement while preparing feedback summaries and comprehensive presidential candidate packets.

Chair Stockwell thanked all of the presidential candidates for their interest in leading and serving Valencia College, and in particular, the seven presidential semi-finalist candidates for investing significant professional time while participating in the presidential candidate interviews and town hall events.

Dr. Amy Bosley, Vice President, Organizational Development and Human Resources, presented an overview of the three-phased Presidential Search Process, which was distributed to the Board.

Dr. Bosley introduced Dr. Melissa Trotta, AGB Search staff member to the Board. Dr. Trotta shared a review of the Presidential Search applicant pool characteristics.

Dr. Bosley shared important reminders related to equity-minded hiring practices.

Dr. Bosley thanked the Presidential Search Committee, the AGB Search team, and Valencia's faculty, staff, and students for their engagement and feedback during the Presidential Search process.

Dr. Bosley thanked Trustee Dr. Carlson for serving as a member of the Presidential Search Committee.

Dr. Bosley thanked Chair Stockwell for her leadership.

Chair Stockwell stated that the Presidential Search Committee now has concluded its work, and the remainder of the Presidential Search process will be completed by the District Board of Trustees of Valencia College. For reasons of continuity and efficiency, the Presidential Search Committee shall remain intact until decommissioned by the Board.
