In Spring 2020:

4,000+ sections transitioned from face-to-face instruction to online

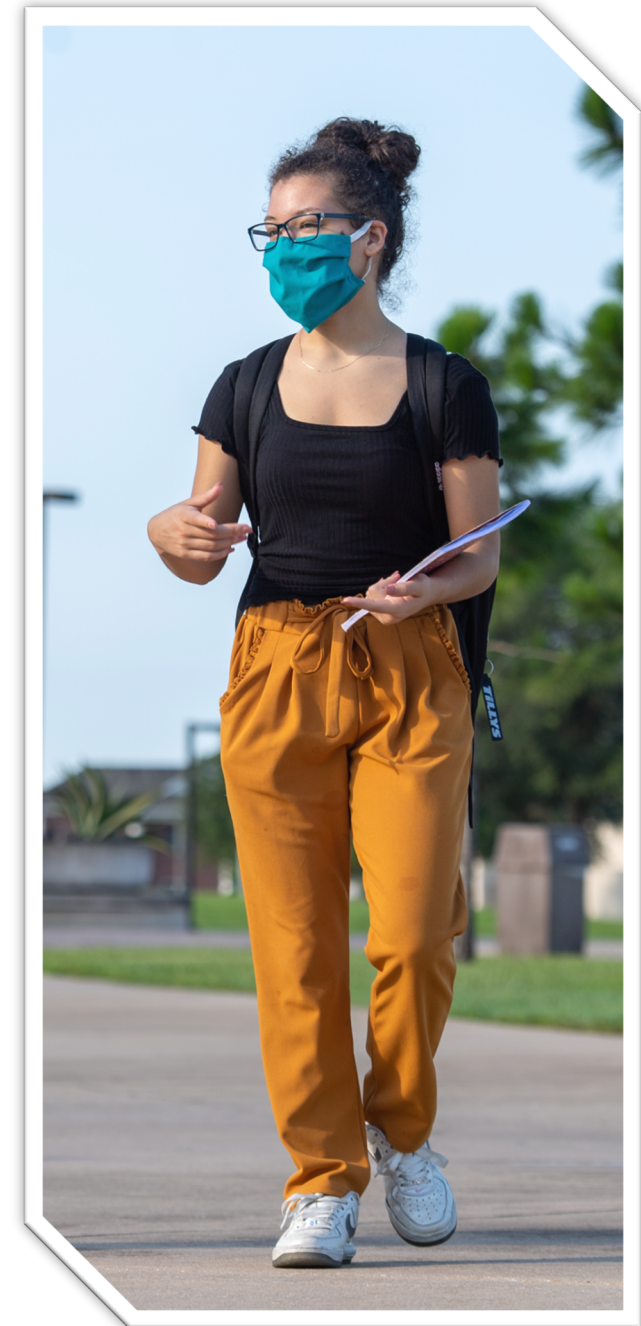
