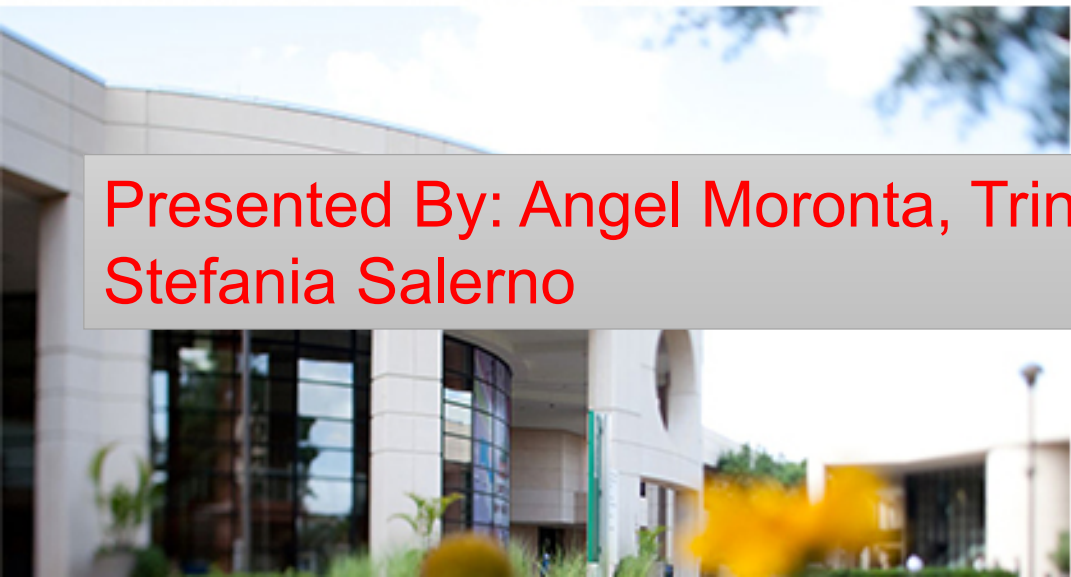

Transportation Challenges

- **Having enough buses on certain routes**
Some routes have a bus between 25-35 mins and depending on the time of day, buses can be delayed by an extra 15-20 mins and or overly crowded.
- **Some areas don't have enough buses**
An example is buses going to Apopka come between every hour to even two hours.
- **Some areas have no transportation or accessible transportation.**
This requires you to walk at least a mile in between stops or aren't accessible for 3 miles or more in areas like Osceola.
- **Bus routes are less accessible at night**
This is a safety issue in some areas and impacts how quickly and safely students are able to get home.
- **We must look at extra ways of transportation, extra routes, safety and health.**

Opportunities for All Valencia Students

- Valencia College is an open access Institution
- The Department of Education (ED) released new guidance on the third round of Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) grants authorized by the American Rescue Plan.
- The final regulations discusses student eligibility, which allows undocumented students, those enrolled in the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program, and international students to access the emergency grants.
