January 2022 Featured Sponsored Project: FL Dept. of State Division of Library and Information Services (DLIS) CARES Funding

In December 2020, the FL DLIS awarded \$92,383 to the Valencia College Library. This was federal flow down money from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus pandemic.


Funds supported three major initiatives:

- 1. Establishment of a Hot Spot Circulation Program
- 2. Expanded Tech Support Services for Students
- 3. Programming to support student connections and discussion of salient social justice issues during a time of isolation due to social distancing

UPDATE: In December 2021, DLIS approved Valencia College for an additional \$25,697 in American Rescue Plan Act funding to provide students with safe learning environments as colleges adjust to "the new normal." Valencia will purchase Vibe Boards to support online library instruction sessions.

The Valencia College Library partnered with the Campus Store to distribute T-Mobile 4G LTE HotSpots to students available by both mail and pickup. Results from a survey given to students using the hotspots found that over 94% said these devices helped them succeed in their classes.


