RE: AWARD OF REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) 2023-01, ARCHITECTURAL CONTINUING SERVICES

On August 05, 2022, the College issued a Request for Qualifications, RFQ #2023-01, Architectural Continuing Services. The solicitation seeks to provide the College with qualified Architectural Consultants for various Valencia College projects via a continuing service contract. The contracted work will be determined by Valencia College and be in compliance with Florida Statute 287.055 (2)(g).

Proposals for the RFQ were received and opened on September 8, 2022. The following 20 firms submitted proposals in response to the solicitation:

A public evaluation meeting was held on September 19, 2022, to review qualifications. Four committee members reviewed and ranked the proposals based on the following criteria: business structure, proposed team members and responsibilities, team's design experience with continuing service contracts, team's experience with higher education, and proximity/location.

In accordance with the RFQ process, the Evaluation Committee elected to move directly to final selection of the five highest ranked firms: HuntonBrady Architects, Rhodes Brito Architects, Schenkel & Shultz, Inc., DLR Group, and KMA Design Group, LLC.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The President recommends that the District Board of Trustees of Valencia College award contracts for RFQ #2023-01, Architectural Continuing Services to five (5) firms, HuntonBrady Architects, Rhodes Brito Architects, Schenkel & Shultz, Inc., DLR Group, and KMA Design Group, LLC. subject to the negotiation of mutually agreeable contracts.
