



CONSTRUCTION REPORT October 2017

East Campus: School of Arts and Entertainment

The building opened for classes August 28, 2017. A few punch-list items are still being resolved by the contractor, but the facility is 100% operational.

Poinciana Campus: Building 1 and Central Utility Plant and Center for Accelerated Training (CAT)

The building opened for classes August 28, 2017. A few punch-list items are still being resolved by the contractor, but the facility is 100% operational.

East Campus: Building 1B Interior Renovation

Borelli Architects has begun design for the renovation of approximately 11,000 SF in Building 1B. This is the area vacated by the occupants of the new School of Arts & Entertainment Building (FSMT). The renovated area will include a new physics lab, two classrooms, an open office suite for Valencia College faculty and an open office suite for UCF, as well as a remodeled print shop and word processing suite.

Osceola Campus: Center for Accelerated Training (CAT) Building

Design has begun for the CAT building. The construction management firm Wharton-Smith has been chosen as the general contractor for this project.

Osceola Campus: Career in Technology Building (CIT)

A firm is scheduled to be selected October 17, 2017.

An RFQ has been released for the design-build of a new two-story, 35,000 SF facility that will house a new electro-mechanical engineering lab, computer electronics labs, two traditional computer labs, ten lecture classrooms, administration suites, and one small mock-apartment unit for the Hospitality Program.
