Continuing Education Overview

- Continuing Professional Education provides non-degree programs, short-term training, advanced/specialized training, workshops and services that focus on workforce development for local organizations, business professionals, and students.
- Continuing International Education provides non-degree programs for local and international students in the areas of languages and international workforce development.



Continuing Education FY1314

- Total Revenue increased by 40% over previous year.
- Enrollment increase in 90% of the programs offered.
- Total number of enrollments in all programs offered was 10,766 and 3,801 serviced in the testing center.
- New enrollment highs in programs such as Intensive English (IE) and Public Safety Leadership Development Programs.
- Increased the number of transfer students (62) from IE to degree programs.
- 40 new business agreements in workforce development and international partners.



Continuing Education FY1415 Update

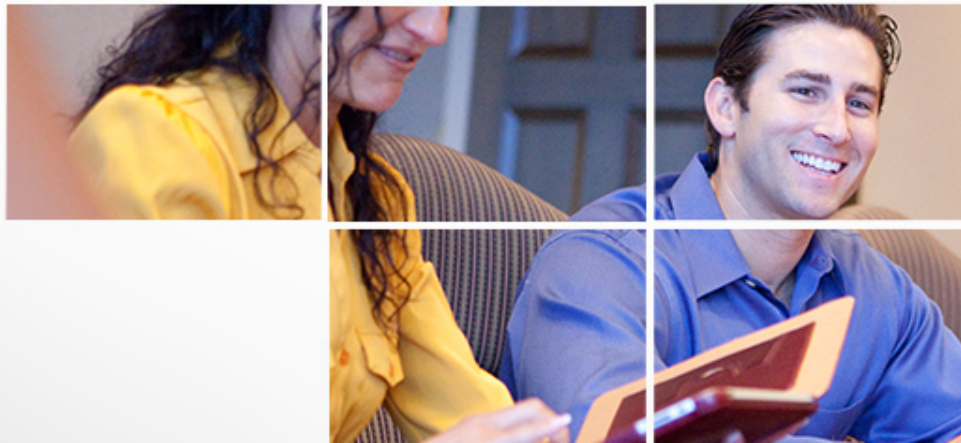
- Revenue increase of 29% as of 9/30 over same period last year.
- Intensive English (IE) enrollments have increased 70% over same period last year.
- Expansion of IE to the Osceola Campus planned for Spring 2015.
- Award of \$2.5M Advanced Manufacturing TAACCCT grant from the USDOL/USDOE.

International Student Services FY1314

- Total number of enrollments for fall, spring, and summer were 1,207 which was 107% of the enrollment plan.
- Enrollments increased by 16% over the previous year.
- Recruitment staff visited 8 different international cities and collected information from over 2,000 prospective students interested in Valencia College.
- International degree students came from over 86 countries with significant increases from Venezuela, Brazil, Bahamas, and Angola.



International Student Services FY1415

- Total fall enrollment of 590 is 104% of the plan.
- The enrollment was an increase of 34% over the previous fall.
- Recruitment staff visited Brazil and Vietnam in September/October to give high school presentations, meet with partners, and attend college fairs.
- Spring enrollment activity is currently on track to achieve the enrollment plan of 552.
