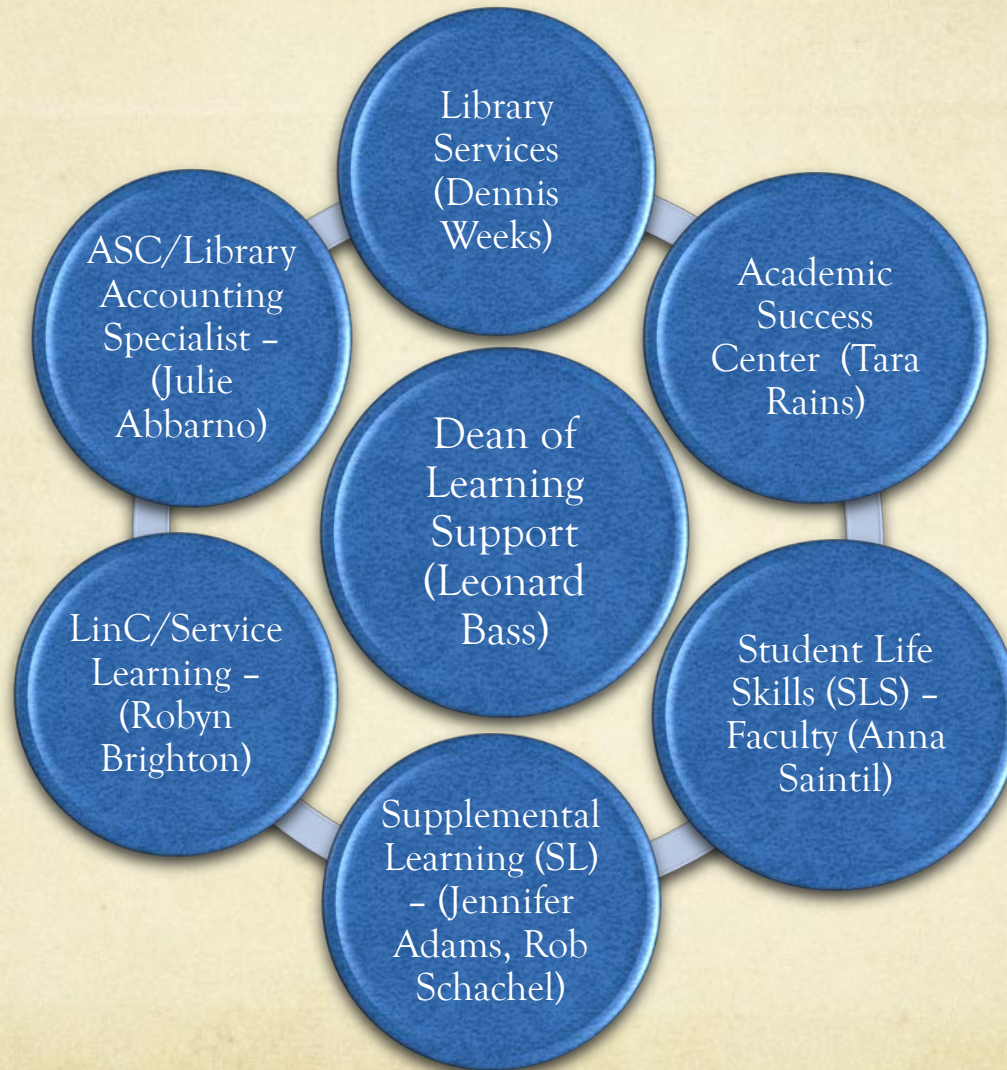

Background

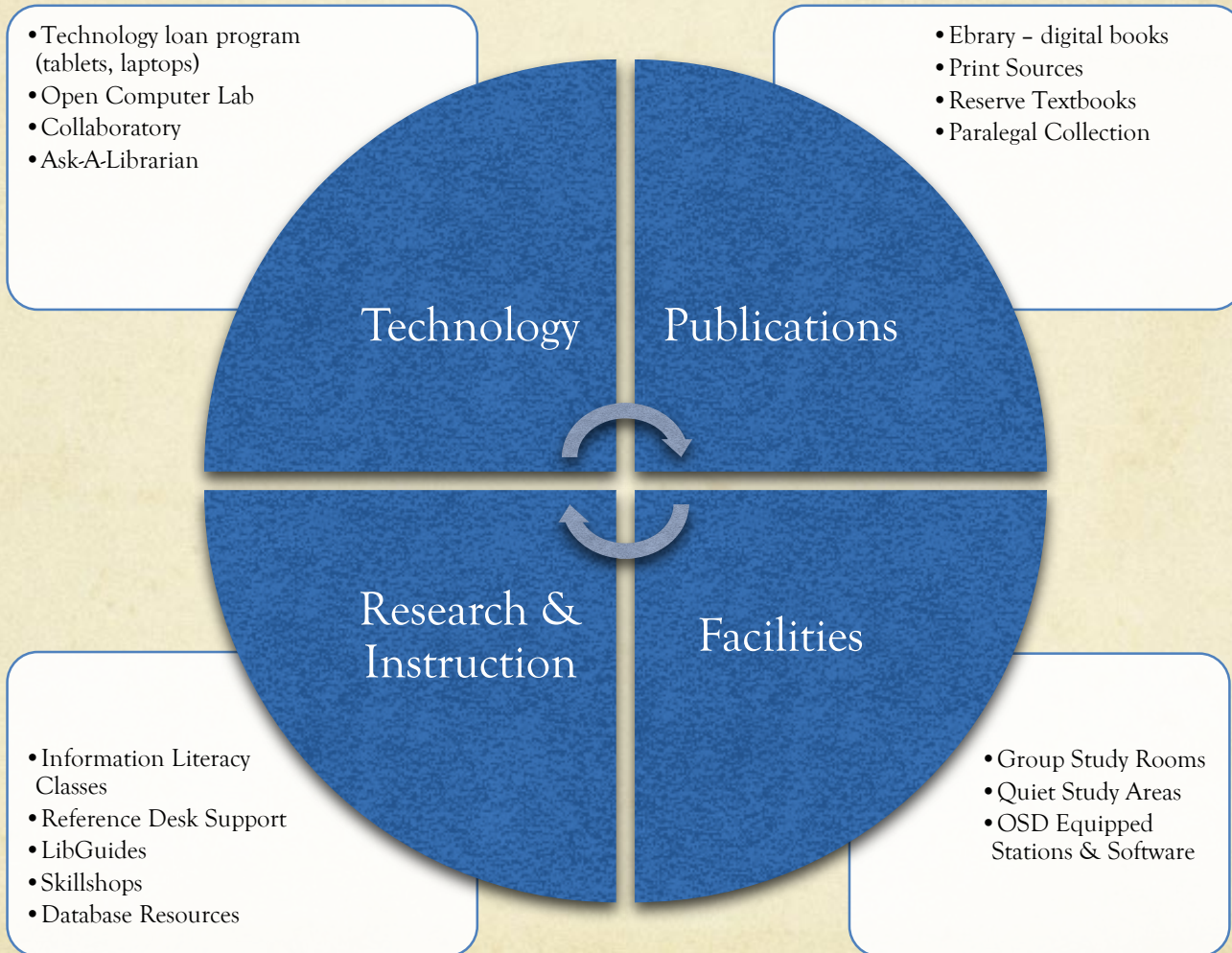

Organizational Structure



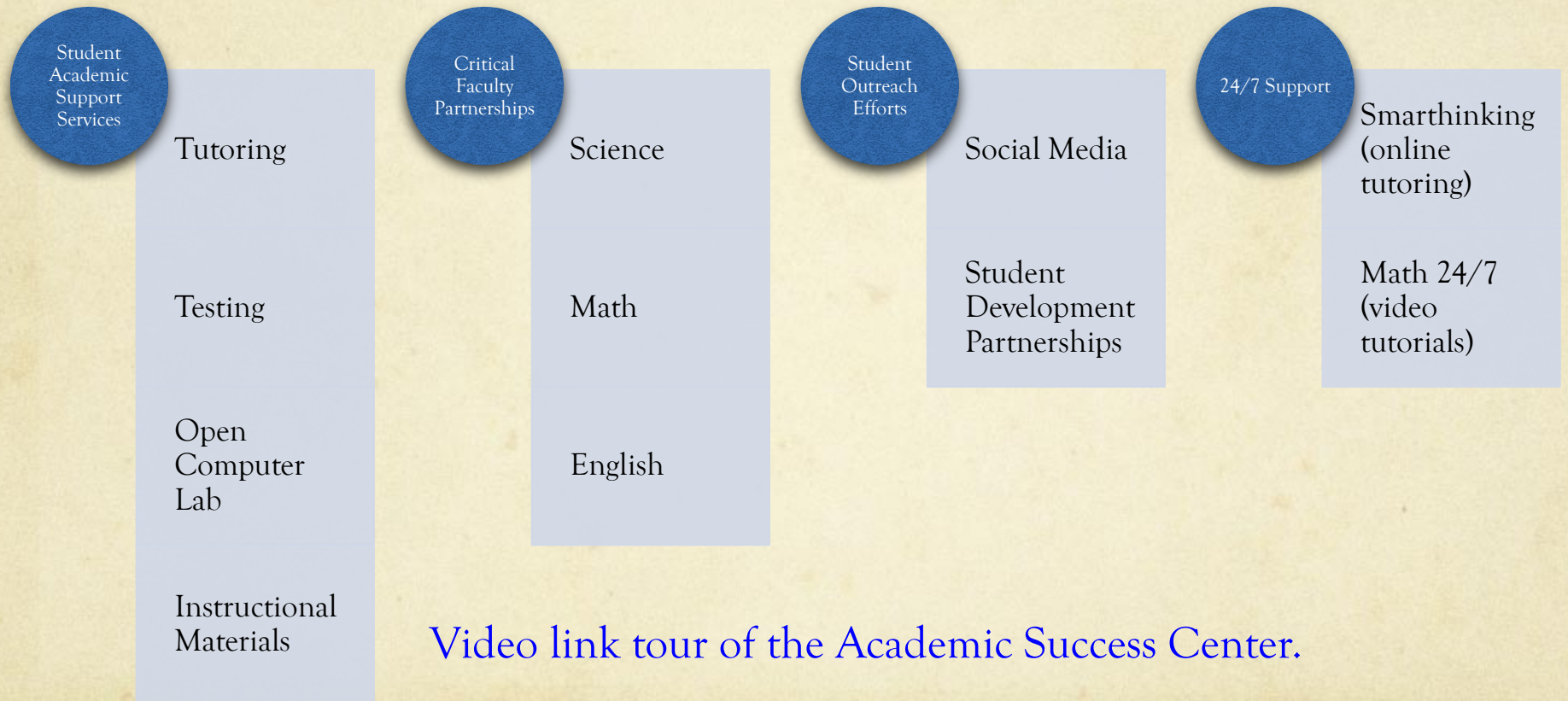

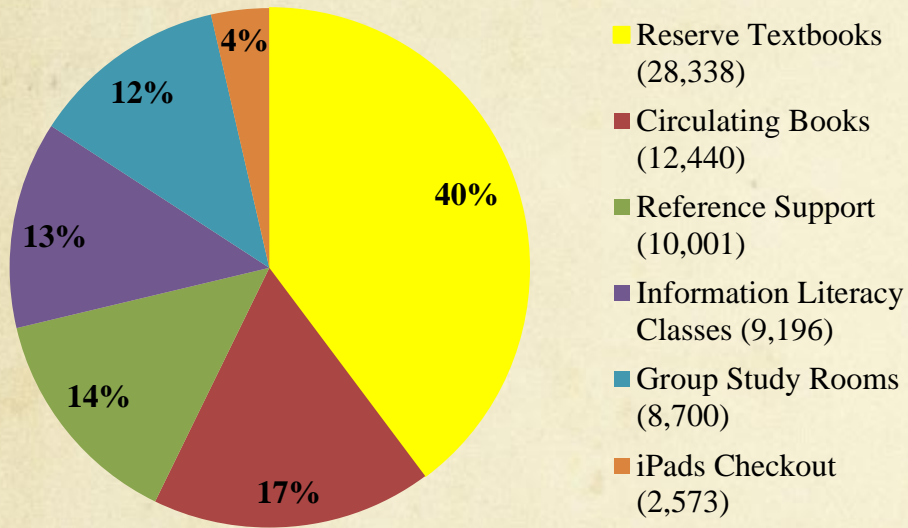

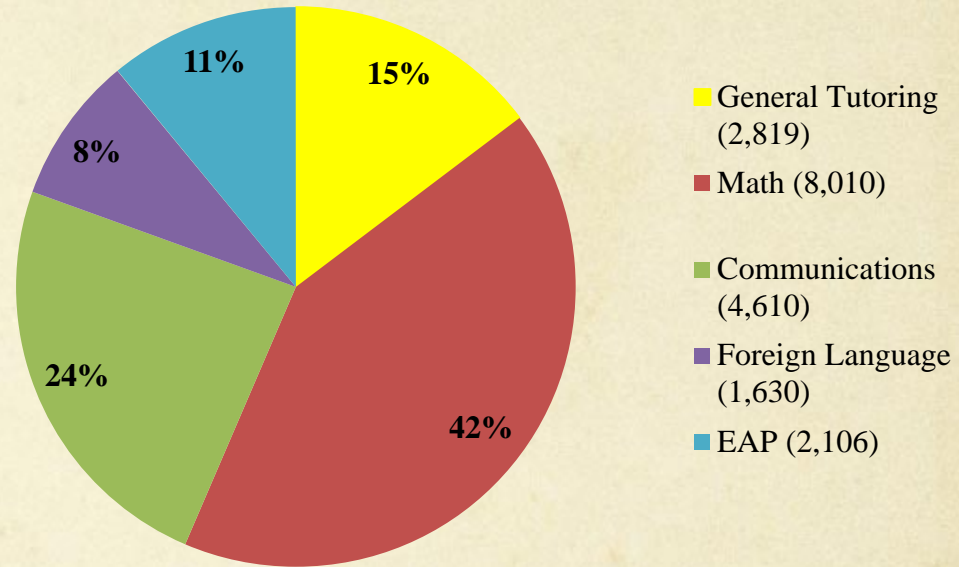

EXPLORING RESOURCES

3

CLASSROOM ASSESSMENT TECHNIQUES

Participants will analyze current CAT strategies to determine how they can align with their CARE plan.

4

EARLY ALERT

Participants will investigate early alert strategies with a community of Valencia colleagues.

5

DEVELOP A CARE PLAN
