




Context:



In 2013, Valencia and UCF were invited to participate in **Engaging Latino Students for Transfer and College Completion** sponsored by CCSSE, NSSE, and Excelencia in Education.







Data:



- 41% of all transfer students at UCF are from Valencia
- 18% of FTIC students at UCF are Latino
- 28% of Valencia transfers at UCF are Latino
- 66% of all Valencia transfer students complete a bachelor's degree within four academic years at UCF
- 66% of Latino males and 64% of Latina females who transfer from Valencia complete a bachelor's degree within four academic years





How could we build upon a nationally recognized model to develop an enhanced pathway for students who come to Valencia planning to seek a degree from UCF?



Design:



- Cohort-based experience to create a learning community
- Reduce "unknowns" in students' schedule
- Include meaningful and connected co-curricular experiences
- Create experiences for students to "feel" like UCF Knights while at Valencia

- Cohort-based enrollment for students wishing to major in psychology/social sciences or business
- Guaranteed schedule at Valencia leading to Associate of Arts with all program prerequisites


