

NON-MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON CAMPUS

Policy Statement:

Non-motorized methods of travel (bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, roller blades and any other means of wheeled travel) are prohibited on campus or on any other facility operated by the College.

Procedures:

Non-motorized methods of travel include but are not limited to: bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, roller blades and any other means of wheeled travel and foot travel.

Sidewalks:

Bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, roller blades and any other means of wheeled travel are *prohibited from being operated on campus sidewalks* with the exception of (1) equipment designed for and used by disabled persons and (2) vehicles owned and operated by Valencia or an approved authorized contractor. Sidewalks are designated for pedestrian travel, except as outlined above; for the purpose of this policy pedestrian travel is defined as *foot travel* without the use of any other device(s).

Parking Lots, Access and Perimeter Roadways:

1. Bicycles are regulated and defined by Florida statute and as such are allowed to be operated similarly to vehicles having access to parking lots and are expected to follow all rules of the road. Upon arrival at campus bicycles must be walked from the parking lot areas to designated bicycle storage racks.
2. Skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, roller blades and any other means of wheeled travel are *prohibited from being operated in campus parking lots* with the exception of those designed and

used by disabled persons and vehicles owned and operated by Valencia or an approved authorized contractor. Persons traveling to campus using any non-motorized method of travel are expected to stop operation when they arrive on campus.

3. In accordance with Florida Statute 316.2065 Section 3 (12) no skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, roller blades and any other means of wheeled travel may go upon any roadway except while crossing a street on a crosswalk and are thereby *prohibited from being operated on campus roadways*.
4. All the above prohibitions apply inside of all buildings.
