Report Summary

- This Registration report provides the number of students enrolled (headcount) and credits enrolled (FTE = full time equivalent) for Summer term 2013; for the college overall and by campus. It also shows a comparison to Summer term 2012. The campus student headcount adds to more than the collegewide overall headcount because some students attend classes on more than one campus in the same term.
- The Student Characteristics report provides information about students enrolled in Summer 2013 including student status (new/returning/high school grads), age, race/ethnicity, and degree intent. It also indicates any changes in these characteristics compared to Summer 2012 term students.

- 5.3% Asian/Pacific Islander (+0.2%; -27 in number)
- 35.9% Caucasian (-0.2% in proportion; -602 in number)
- 30.3% Hispanic (+0.7% in proportion; -282 in number)
- 0.3% Native American (+0.1; +6 in number)
- 10.1% Other (-0.3% in proportion; -214 in number)

● **81.6% degree/certificate seeking students (+1% in proportion; -1004 in number)**

- 59% AA (11,773; +2% in proportion, -150 in number)
- 41% AS/AAS/Certificate (8,179; -2% in proportion, -854 in number)
