RE: THE POWER TO SERVE; VALENCIA'S FIVE-YEAR IMPACT PLAN-DBOT

GOALS ADDED

On November 2, 2016, "The Power to Serve: Valencia's Five-Year Impact Plan, 2016-2021" was presented for consideration and approval to the District Board of Trustees. After a full discussion, the Board requested that the Plan be amended to include additional goals. The College's Strategic Planning Steering Committee has amended Valencia's Impact Plan to reflect the input of the Board by adding goals of increasing the college going rate to Valencia by recent high school graduates from Orange and Osceola counties, closing the performance gaps among students from diverse backgrounds, and increasing the diversity of the faculty, staff, and leadership of the college.

Deeply rooted in the College's experience, all of the goals contained in the Impact Plan project our core work into the future, calling us to action to improve our students' lives and the life of the community that we serve. Although Valencia already has served the community through its service to students, the College is embarking on an enhanced community partnership that we have not yet experienced. As the College executes this Impact Plan, Central Florida will begin to see Valencia as an essential partner in addressing and solving the region's problems and goals.

- a. Create and implement a strategic recruitment plan to maximize exposure for Valencia job vacancies with individuals from diverse backgrounds.
