Requirement of Accident and Hospitalization Insurance for International Students

Policy Statement:

All international students enrolling at Valencia College in F-1 visa status are required to have, as part of international student admission and enrollment requirements, adequate accident and hospitalization insurance effective in the United States and through a company approved by the college.

Policy History:

Procedures:

- I. The college will identify and approve, designated insurance carrier for accident and hospitalization coverage.
- II. Payment for purchase of insurance coverage will be made through the College Business Office prior to registration.

- III. Only students participating in government or embassy sponsored programs or F1 visa holders who are dependents of permanent residents who are providing adequate accident or hospitalization insurance may be eligible as an exception to this policy.
- IV. Failure to purchase accident and hospitalization insurance as designated by the college will result in denial of registration.
