

## Example: Journal Article - With Digital Object Identifier (DOI)



## In-text citation


First citation: Terence Cuneo explains that "text of quotation" (615).

Subsequent citations: Cuneo states "text of quotation" (615).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Cuneo 615).

## **Example: Periodical Article**



First citation: Patti Smith explains that "text of quotation" (112). **Subsequent** citations: Smith states "text of quotation" (112). OR

"Text of quotation" (Smith 615).

\* The date of access is optional; however, it is commonly used. When using optional elements, refer to your assignment or course guidelines or preferences expressed by your professor.
