

Example: Periodical Article - Two Authors




First in-text citation: According to Evan Gutman and Michael H. Karu "text of quotation."

Subsequent citations: Gutman and Evan confirm "text of quotation."

OR "Text of quotation" (Gutman and Evan).


Example: Broadcast Interview - Transcript



First in-text citation: According to Scott Weaver and others "text of quotation." **Subsequent** citations: Weaver and others discussed "text of quotation."

OR "Text of quotation" (Weaver et al.).

Example: Company Information - Corporate Author



In-text citation: "Genentech, Inc." lists "text of quotation." OR

[&]quot;Text of quotation" ("Genentech, Inc.").
