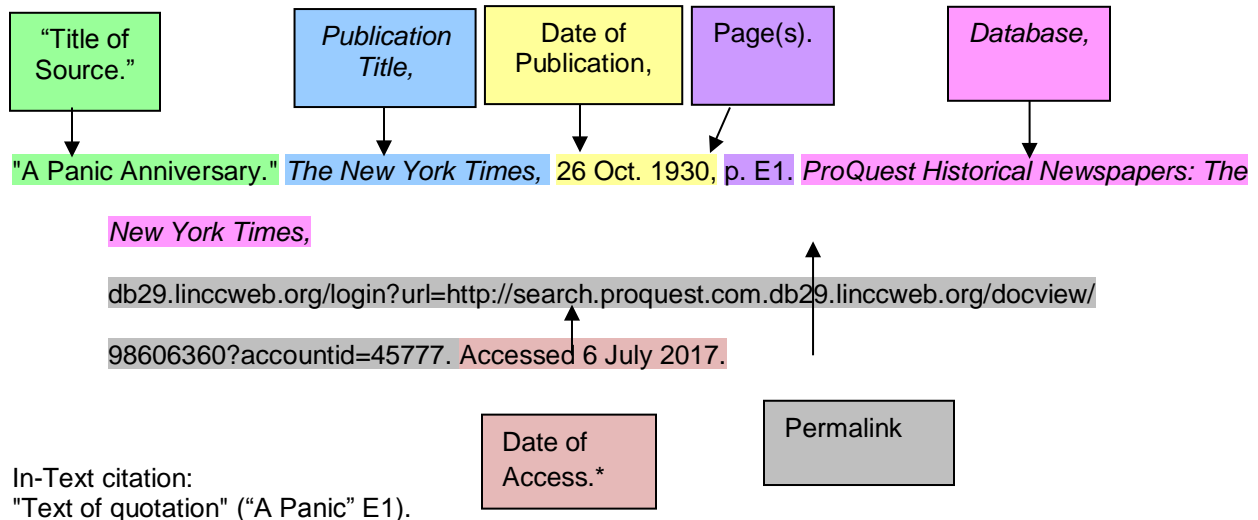

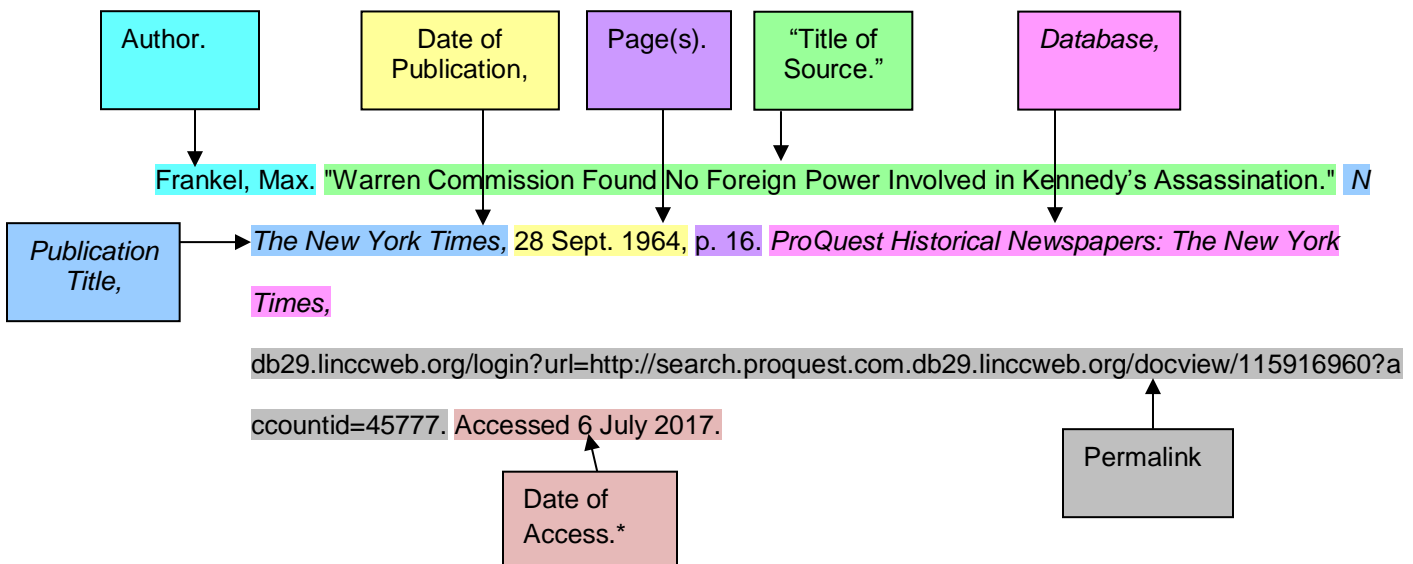

First in-text citation: Max Frankel explains "text of quotation" (16).

Subsequent citations: Frankel emphasizes "text of quotation" (16).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Frankel 16).
