


Example: Journal Article - No Digital Object Identifier (DOI)




Example: Journal Article - Two Authors - With Digital Object Identifier (DOI)



First in-text citation: F.H.J. Venter and J.E. Wolvaardt explain "text of quotation" (772). **Subsequent** citations: Venter and Wolvaardt describe "text of quotation" (772). OR

[&]quot;Text of quotation" (Venter and Wolvaardt 772).

Example: Periodical Article - No Author



In-text citation: "Text of quotation" ("Private Chlamydia").
