


Example: Book Online Entry



First in-text citation: Beverly Ballaro explains "text of quotation" (3). **Subsequent** citations: Ballaro detail "text of quotation" (3). OR

"Text of quotation" (Ballaro 3).

Example: Periodical Article



First in-text citation: Simon Brown explains "text of quotation" (13). **Subsequent** citations: Brown describes "text of quotation" (13). OR "Text of quotation" (Brown 13)
