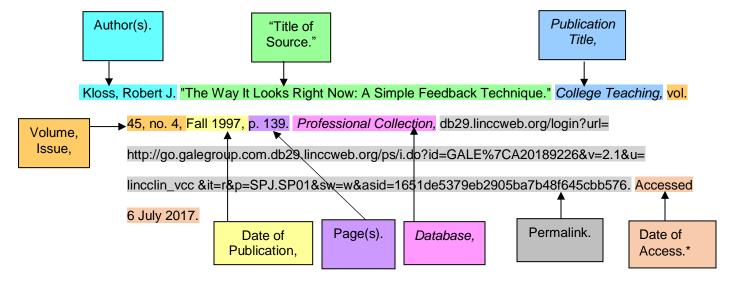

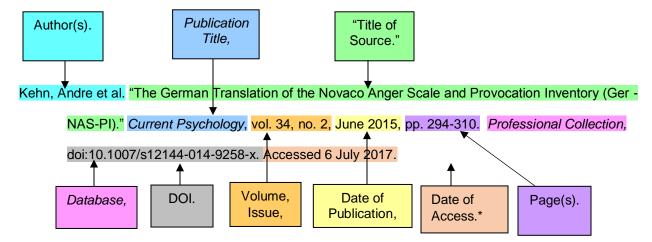
Example: Journal Article - No Pagination - No Digital Object Identifier (DOI)



First citation: Robert J. Kloss explains "text of quotation". **Subsequent** citations: Kloss states "text of quotation". OR

"Text of quotation" (Kloss).

Example: Journal Article - More than Three Authors - With Digital Object Identifier (DOI)



First citation: Andre Kehn and others explain "text of quotation" (295). **Subsequent** citations: Kehn et al. state "text of quotation" (295). OR

[&]quot;Text of quotation" (Kehn et al. 296).
