


**Example: Book Online – Entry** 



First in-text citation: According to Kari Lucke "Text of quotation." **Subsequent** citations: Lucke states "text of quotation."

OR

## **Example: Journal Article - Multiple Authors**



<sup>&</sup>quot;Text of quotation" (Lucke).

First in-text citation: According to John Bugalla and others "text of quotation" (35). **Subsequent** citations: Bugalla et al. believe "text of quotation." (35). OR

"Text of quotation" (Bugalla et al. 35).
