Example: Book Online




First in-text citation: According to Sidney George Fisher "text of quotation" (65). **Subsequent** citations: Fisher claims "text of quotation" (65).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Fisher 65).

Example: Book Online - Song



First in-text citation: George W. Bungay describes "text of quotation."

Subsequent citations: Bungay proclaims "text of quotation."

OR

"Text of quotation" (Bungay).
