Qualifications for Undergraduate Research Mentor:

- 1) Academic/Professional Experience:
 - Have you completed original research in your area of expertise?
 - Have you published in your area of expertise? How recently?
 - Have you presented your research in a public forum?
- 2) Area Specific Experience:
 - Are you current with the research in your field?
 - Are you current with the research methodology in your field?
 - Have you collaborated with areas outside of your discipline? To what extent?
- 3) Undergraduate Research Advising Experience:
 - Have you ever served as an undergraduate research advisor? Explain
 - How long did you work with your student(s)?
 - How frequently did you meet with your student(s) to discuss their research?
 - Did your student(s) complete their own original research project?
 - Did your student(s) complete a research paper or present their findings at a conference?
 - Have you ever served on a thesis/dissertation committee?
 - Have you ever taught a research methodology course? Or a class that incorporated research?
- *4) Ethics Experience*:
 - Have you completed your discipline's ethical training in the last 10 years?
 - Have you ever requested IRB approval for a research project? With Valencia?
- 5) Safety Experience*:
 - Do you have familiarity with laboratory safety protocols? Date of last safety training?
 - Do you have experience with OSHA regulations?
 - Any other safety considerations regarding research projects (electrical, physical, etc.)?
